- 1. The Church is part of the one people of God across redemptive-history, but it is the <u>new</u> covenant people!
 - A. Same good news: salvation by grace through faith
 - i. Gospel clarity and specificity in Jesus Christ
 - ii. Same language used of both Israel and Church
 - iii. Same God, but greater clarity (i.e., _____)
 - B. Different in structure and nature
 - i. Direct mediation through Christ, not leaders
 - ii. Better promises—new hearts, new minds, Spiritindwelt, law written on the hearts and minds, full forgiveness of sins, power of sin is broken, slaves to Christ, justified/sanctified/glorified, adoption as sons, holiness, all know the Lord (fully regenerate)
 - iii. In Christ, new creation—already, not yet
 - iv. In Christ, new temple—holiness & mediation
 - v. In Christ, new humanity—reconciliation (up/out)
